

**Athletic Waiver For P.E./Health**

- 1) Playing a sport will waive the P.E. requirement if the proper form is filed in the high school office and on time. Requirement - one sport for one semester - no credit will be earned but a waiver will appear on the transcript. Sport will be noted on transcript also.
- 2) Sports sponsored by Dryden High School will be the only sport accepted (M.H.S.A.A. recognized). All high school sports can be taken for a P.E. waiver (Golf - must be on the actual playing team).
- 3) Waivers must be turned by the day following the first contest. Attendance may be a requirement used to determine if the waiver is accepted or not.
- 4) Only students in grades 9<sup>th</sup> - 11<sup>th</sup> are eligible to use the athletics for a P.E. waiver. First semester seniors may also use athletics for a P.E. waiver but not during their final semester of their senior year. This will only be allowed as long as they can make up P.E./Health second semester and be eligible to graduate.
- 5) Students must declare their intent to use athletics for P.E. waiver by the day following the first contest for that particular sport. A parent/guardian signature is required for this form.
- 6) If at anytime during the school year the instructor and principal feel that students who are taking athletics for P.E./Health waiver need to be exposed to certain information, they will be instructed in those areas by being brought back into the classroom for that specific topic(s) (ie. aids).
- 7) If a student is dropped from the team or quits before the season is over, no waiver will be granted.
